

Supply List for Quilter's Quickies: Fast, Easy and Fun Projects to Whip Up at the Last Minute

Basic Sewing Supplies – sewing machine in good working order, rotary cutter & mat, iron & ironing surface, good quality sewing thread in a neutral color.

Project #1 – Sew Easy Pillowcase (Standard size)

Pillowcase body – $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (for King size pillowcase you'll need 1 yard)
Accent Strip – 2" strip width of fabric
Pillowcase cuff – $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Project #2 – Easy Striped Table Runner

Note: yardage depends on how long a table runner you want. Purchase your preferred length plus 9". The extra length will be trimmed to create the pointed ends of the runner.
Striped fabric – the fabric needs to have two 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide repeats (selvage to selvage) (kits will be available for sale in class)
Backing fabric of your choice
Lightweight batting or flannel
Thread
8" Creative Grid 60 degree ruler (available for sale in class) or long rotary ruler with 60 degree markings
Walking foot for machine quilting.

Project #3 – Christmas Ornament Table Runner

Three 15" squares of backing fabric (Christmas theme is good)
Three 15" squares of flannel (or lightweight batting that can withstand heat)
Six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" rectangles for ornament top (gold colored or cotton lamé would work well)
Assorted Christmas color strips of various widths and at least 15" long
Thread for machine quilting

Project #4 – QuiltSmart Cell Phone Bag (\$10)

The kit for this class includes the pattern and accessories for three bags. You may make one or all three.

To make one bag with a fabric strap you'll need $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of fabric
2 fat quarters (18"x22") will make 3 bags with the ready made strap OR 2 bags with fabric straps. You may use 2 coordinating fabrics for the bag also.
